

Chief Of Social Services

POSITION OBJECTIVE/SUMMARY:

Under the direction of the Chief Operations Officer, Program Planning, Development, Monitoring and evaluation. The Chief of Social Services is responsible for overall clinical and administrative coordination of clinical services to ensure that high and effective standards of client care are maintained at all times; provides direct management oversight of all non-licensed social service staff according to state, agency, and other regulatory bodies. The Chief of Social Services is expected to ensure that all aspects of the quality of care are satisfied continuously through facilitation, monitoring and operationalizing of the following:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR THIS POSITION:

- A Master's Degree in Social Work from an accredited college.
- A valid license as a Clinical Social Worker with the California Board of Behavioral Sciences.
- A minimum of six (6) years experience in a psychiatric facility working with clients who are persistently and severely mentally ill preferred.
- Previous management experience in a psychiatric healthcare environment preferred.
- Physically well, emotionally stable, and excellent communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Ability to work with a multidisciplinary treatment team essential.

GENERAL STATEMENT OF FUNCTIONS :

- Accessibility of care - the ease with which all adults and seniors receive the services they need when they are needed.
- Appropriateness of care - the degree to which the correct care is provided.
- Continuity of care - the degree to which the care needed by adults and seniors serviced is coordinated among practitioners and across organization and time.
- Effectiveness of care - the degree to which care (e.g., a procedure) is provided in the correct manner, i.e., the degree to which those served benefit from a given level and/or type of intervention.
