

## Chief Operating Officer of Behavioral Health

The Chief Operating Officer of Behavioral Health is accountable for the administrative, financial, marketing and day-to-day operations of behavioral health services including providing the strategic direction, facilitation, and leadership of the Kedren Acute Psychiatric Hospital & Kedren Primary Care Clinic (FQHC) and four satellite behavioral health clinics. With oversight of nine department heads, approximately 350 full-time equivalent staff.

### **Minimum Qualifications**

Possession of a Master's degree in a clinical or business administration field from an accredited institution (PhD preferred) in organizational development, public healthcare administration or psychology or related field and ten (10) years' experience in a director level role within an organization providing similar services as Kedren.
