

LICENSED SOCIAL WORKER**STATEMENT OF FUNCTIONS:**

The licensed clinical social worker (LCSW) will work to reduce the distress and improve the mental health of underserved populations presenting with complex medical and psycho-social problems. The LCSW will work alongside other professionals in multidisciplinary teams in order to deal with complex patient problems.

Description:

- The LCSW provides social work services including assessment, short term and crisis counseling, individualized care planning, and case coordination to patients and their families.
- Serves as liaison between Kedren Mental Health and the community to integrate services, coordinate care for clients, and enhance relationships through public relations activities.
- Assesses, develops and coordinates a clinical treatment program for patients with acute or chronic moderate to severe mental health disorders.
- Consults with staff regarding diagnosis, strengths and deficits of member, as needed or appropriate.

Qualifications

1. Licensed in the State of California as a Clinical Social Worker (LCSW)
2. Minimum two years of providing mental health services (i.e., assessment, diagnosis, individual and group therapies) to underserved populations, homeless, mentally ill, substance addicted adult populations.
3. Prior experience working within a community mental health or primary care, medical setting preferred.
4. CPR certification required.
5. Proficiency in computer use required.
6. Bilingual (Spanish/English) preferred
