

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

POSITION OBJECTIVE/SUMMARY:

The Occupational Therapist serves as a facilitator of Occupational Therapy activities both in and out-patient services. As an integral part of the treatment team, the Occupational Therapist works collaboratively with other team members to plan the special occupational and activity needs of clients who display a wide variety of mental, emotional, behavioral, psychomotor and perceptual problems.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR THIS POSITION:

- Graduate from an occupational therapy curriculum accredited by the American Occupational Therapy Association Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE).
- Current license or a limited permit for license issued by the California Board of Occupational Therapy as an Occupational Therapist.
- Previous experience in a psychiatric healthcare environment preferred.
- Good verbal and written communication, interpersonal skills, and the ability to interface with all levels of management and associates while building strong relationships.
- Must have the ability to problem solve, meet deadlines and follow through on work assignments in a fast paced work environment.
- The ability to work overtime and/or additional days as needed.
