

PEER ADVOCATE

POSITION OBJECTIVE/SUMMARY:

Under the direct supervision of the Program Director. The Peer Support Worker works as part of a multi disciplinary team and perform a variety of supportive services such as interacting with clients concerning mental health or social service matters, answering questions and providing information regarding available mental health/social services and potential financial resources, coordinating group facilitations, and providing other support and assistance as appropriate.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR THIS POSITION:

- At least six (6) months of mental health peer advocacy paid or volunteer experience working directly with mental health clients, performing such duties as interacting with clients or patients concerning mental health or social service matters, answering questions and providing information about mental health/social services and disability benefits, coordinating group facilitations, interpreting, and providing other support and assistance.
